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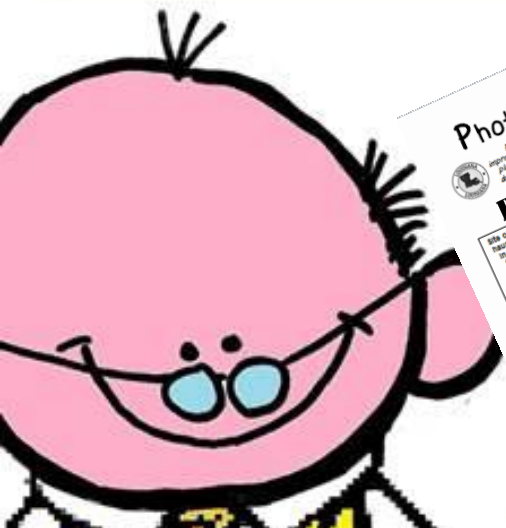


Photo-Bomb my Louisiana

I use them for after an assignment, after a test, after testing at the end of the year, towards the end of class... anytime I just need extra points, or an extra quiet time, I give extra 4-5 points for a completed bingo.

I saw something similar years ago and just got the idea to create a self-bingo that my student might like for extra points since I don't just give extra credit. You have to EARN them if you want them.

This bingo comes from my own webpage timeline throughout Louisiana history and can be done overnight with very little writing plus it is easy to check.

I read blogs, check out web stuff, and check Pinterest, and read various magazines every day so I never know where so idea will hit me.
