Cause & Effect #1:

Cause: The French Revolution in France

Effect: Many French citizens move to Louisiana.

Cause & Effect #2:

Cause: Napoleon takes over as the French Dictator

Effect: Secret Treaty of San Ildefonso

Cause & Effect #3:

Cause: Spanish revoke the right of deposit to the Americans, and Jefferson is worried about going to war with France.

Effect: Jefferson sends Monroe & Livingston to buy Louisiana from France.

Cause & Effect #4:

Cause: Napoleon needs money to start a new war with England.

Effect: Napoleon sells Louisiana to the U.S. / The Louisiana Purchase
