

You will work in groups to create a board game to review your Government Vocabulary.

Step #1: Create question cards.

- a. One for each term and definition.
- b. Fifteen with either a picture, synonym, or example of the vocabulary terms.
- c. Ten with True/False statements related to the vocabulary.

Step #2: Create a die is using the cutout template.

Step #3: Create your own player piece using clay. It will solidify once it dries. The player piece may be no bigger than 1 inch x 1 inch.

Step #4: Decorate/personalize your game board.

- a. Randomly add four "Advance 3 spaces" squares to your board.
- b. Give your game a name.
- c. Draw pictures/color/glue pictures, etc.
- d. Connect the pages of your game board with tape (see example).

How to Play:

- 1. Before you begin, shuffle cards.
- 2. Each player begins at the start square.
- 3. Roll die to determine how many spaces you may advance or go back after answering the question.
- 4. One of the other players will read the top card to the current player.
- 5. If the player gets the answer correct, he/she advances as many spaces as he/she rolled. If the player gets the answer incorrect, he/she goes back as many spaces as he/she rolled.
- 6. First player to reach the finish square wins.
