## Ch. 6 French Era Louisiana

**Directions:** Students will use the information they have learned in class about the early French in Ch. 6 to make a 9-square quilt. Total size of paper quilt will be no more than **30 x 30 inches** - **Each square should be 10"x10"** **MAXIMUM**. Students must work in **PENCIL COLORS** and **BLACK INK**.

### **Materials:**

Construction Paper  
White paper  
Color pencils

Rulers  
Scissors  
Tape

### **Instructions:**

Follow the instructions below.

#### **Square Topics**

1. Picture of Iberville (include some brief background information or Bio info) **Top Left Square**
2. Picture of Fort Maurepas (include some brief background) **Top Middle**
3. Picture of Bienville (include some brief background information or Bio info) **Top Right Square**
4. LaSalle (include some brief background information or Bio info) **Middle Left Square**
5. Map of Louisiana and Mississippi River area (must be colored). This will be the **Center Square**
6. Joliet and Maquette (include some brief background information) **Middle Right Square**
7. Antoine Crozet (include some brief background information or Bio info) **Bottom Left Square**
8. Picture of Fort St. Jean (include some brief background) **Bottom Middle Square**
9. St. Denis (include some brief background information or Bio info) **Bottom Right Square**
10. Put your name AND class period on back.

**\*\*\*When putting together the quilt, make sure you put the quilt squares in the correct places. I will take off points for not following directions, which is what happens on many of this year's projects. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS!**

III. Each Student needs to use one sheet of white paper for topic/background information.

They need to keep all information brief

Must use rulers when needed

Make sure that all your writing parts are level and not all over the place.

All information must be hand-written in **BLACK INK**.

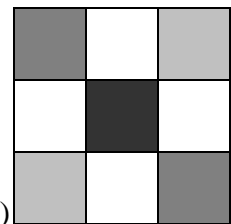
Use **PENCIL COLORS** to attract interest

Cut various colors of construction paper into no more than **10 x 10 inch squares**

Use pictures when possible (you may use the internet, magazines, books, and etc.)

**Hand-write** in large enough letters to make it easy to read

Keep it simple and **NEATNESS counts**



IV. When finished students need to glue each biography sheet to a sheet of construction paper.

(Make sure each construction paper topic sheet is on a different color construction paper or use two colors in a checker board design.)

V. Lay out the pages and tape the back edges where each sheet meets to be put together the quilt. Tape all 9 pages together to form a quilt. Make sure not to put them together too tightly so you can fold the quilt when finished.
