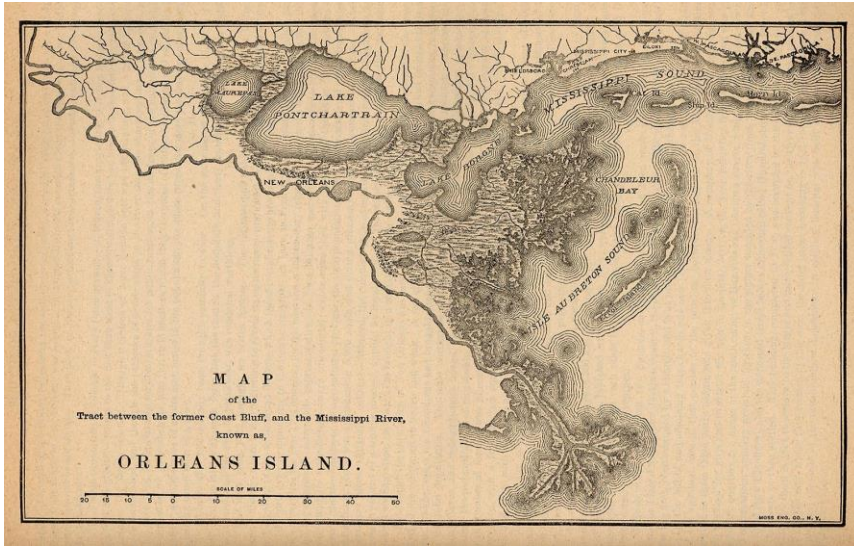

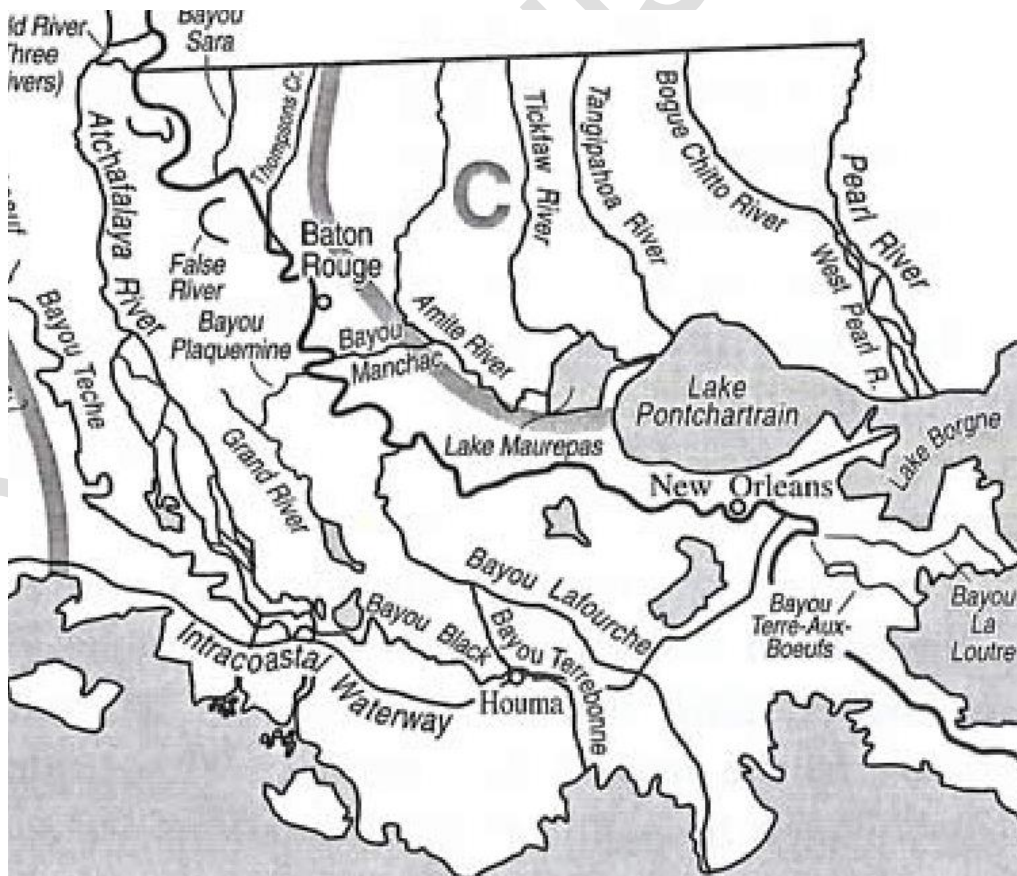

DIRECTIONS: Research internet maps, textbook maps and other state maps to create the Isle, color it in, and label all areas in and around the Isle. Label, New Orleans, the Mississippi, Amite River, Bayou Manchac, Lake Borgne, Lake Maurepas, Chandeleur Bay, Benton Sound, the Gulf of Mexico, the Delta, Lake Pontchartrain, and Pass Manchac. Now color in only the "Isle", the area of New Orleans surround by water (the area surrounded by the Mississippi, Lake Pontchartrain, Lake Maurepas, Pass Manchac, Bayou Manchac, and the Gulf of Mexico).
