Generally I pick letters that are common to words in the Louisiana history text book. I would pick letters such as A, B, C, E, F, I, L, M, N, P, R, S, T AND I.

Music could be an instrument or a musician or a type. The animal could be bird or mammal or fish. The person could be male or female; black or white; French, Spanish, or other nationality. The festivals could be from north Louisiana to south Louisiana, from east to west.
