I place the cards around the room (and sometimes we actually get to do this outside) and students rotate to each card and answer the questions on their answer sheet (attached). I general have students all start in different places so as to not

have a 'herd mentality'. Then we review at the end of class. The kids love it, and it gets them up and moving!

Scoot is an activity that gives students a chance to move around while reinforcing subject matter. This version of SCOOT! Is covering the basics of Primary/Secondary Sources. There are 32 cards, each having one fact asking if this item would be a primary or secondary source.
